DIRECTIONS:

#1

From the City Line Area and beyond:

Take the Schuylkill Expressway (North) to Roosevelt Blvd. Stay in the center, then on the left. At Rising Sun Avenue (approx. 7 lights) turn left. Stay on Rising Sun Avenue to Cottman (called "5 Points"). Cross Cottman taking Oxford Avenue for 2 traffic lights. Stay on right; at 2nd light bear right onto Verree Road for 6 streets to Hartel Avenue. Turn right to 2nd block of houses.....1009. Park anywhere.

#2

From the Pennsylvania Turnpike:

Take U.S. 1 South (Roosevelt Blvd.), stay on right to Rhawn Street (approx. 6½ miles). Turn right onto Rhawn Street and travel awhile to Verree Road. Turn left for 6 streets; turn left onto Hartel Avenue.

#3

From Center City (Philadelphia):

Get onto Schuylkill Expressway; travel West for awhile until you see signs indicating North. Follow signs to Roosevelt Blvd. and repeat directions for #1. If you are closer to I-95, or are coming from the South and generally use I-95...go North to Cottman Exit. Turn right at light (State Road) North to Rhawn - left on Rhawn Street to Verree Road - left on Verree Road for 6 streets to Hartel - left on Hartel to 1009.

#4

From New Jersey:

a) Take the Tacony-Palmyra Bridge; turn right at the end of the bridge when you are on the Philadelphia side onto North State Road. Stay on State Road to Rhawn; turn left onto Rhawn Street and stay on Rhawn Street (follow directions of #2).

b) Betsy Ross Bridge to I-95 - north to Cottman Exit - follow directions in #3 on I-95 north.
