## Femme Fare Daily

This newsletter is an important communications link between each of you, the Steering Committee and the local community. It is the only effective way that we have found to keep you apprised of daily events that have not been published in the F. F. package of information that you have received. It will also indicate any changes in already planned programs that have to be made. Please read this newsletter daily, in order to be up to date on scheduled events. Some schedule changes have already been made and more may be necessary.

The Femme Fare will be distributed by your Residence Coordinators on the evening preceding the effective date of the issue. See next item for information on Residence Coordinators.

You may feel free to submit any item of interest that you would like to have printed in the newsletter, although such items cannot appear before the Tuesday issue. Any item you want to submit should be written legibly and given to your Residence Coordinator no later than 12:30 PM on the day before you want it to appear. Note that this is a change from the 3:00 PM time, and a change from the location for items to be submitted, that was announced in Newsletter #3 (p. 6) that you received prior to arrival.

## Residence Coordinators

This year, each of the four hotels allotted to FF will have a Residence Coordinator or Coordinators who will help you with any problems relating to your living accommodations. Please see your Residence Coordinator for anything relating to hotel maintenance, such as changing light bulbs, making repairs, etc. Your Coordinator will also deliver the newsletter each day and will provide you with any other information that may be helpful.

## ID Cards

The package of information that you received contains a yellow ID card. Please print your femmename on this card and carry the card with you at all times. You must have this card for admission to all scheduled FF events.

Phone Calls

Outgoing calls can be made from the pay phone booth located in the registration area of Gifford House. You may want to use this, as you will find that none of the rooms have phones. However, for long calls, it is suggested that you use a public phone booth to avoid tying up the Gifford House phone for long periods. There are many phone booths throughout P-Town.

Incoming calls should all be directed to Gifford House, for greatest efficiency. Please advise anyone whom you expect to call you to call Gifford House and ask for you by the name that you have given for this purpose on the registration form. If you direct calls to another hotel, the calls will have to be relayed to Gifford House, and a phone call will be wasted.

The number at Gifford House (both outgoing and incoming) is: (617) 487-9821. This is the same number given as the official FF number in the previous Newsletter #3 (p. 3). This phone is open 24 hours.

Gifford House

This year, Gifford House replaces the Crown and Anchor as the center of FF activities. All regular seminars and fashion-beauty courses will be held at Gifford House.

Towels

The hotel managements have requested that you do not use hotel towels to remove makeup, as they are then very difficult to clean. Please use tissues or paper towels. If these are not available tonight (Friday), please use toilet tissue and obtain other tissue tomorrow.

Makeup Demonstration

Tonight (Friday) at 8:00 PM, Valane Paula Neilsen, our Fashion and Makeup Coordinator for FF, will give a makeup demonstration at Gifford House. Entitled "From Paul to Paula", this will feature the complete transformation to Paula's femmeself. Those of you interested in proper makeup application (and aren't we all) should find this fascinating.

Afternoon Outdoor Activities
