Congratulations to both you & Ernest, for his dancing at the MLK Jr Celebration, and you for making Page 1 of the Sentinel. You're so cool, Alyn!

Good news: my plastic surgeon WILL still operate on me to give me a left ball, sometime in Feb. I'm so relieved, cuz if I'm going to get dead, I want 2 balls at THAT MOMENT. Small consolation. but consolation nonetheless....
