Fair's goal is understanding of crossdresser lifestyle

PROVINCETOWN — The fourth annual "Fantasia Fair" for crossdressers, transgenderists and transsexuals will be held in Provincetown from Friday to Oct. 22.

The fair is an educational and social endeavor designed to assist persons who have been involved with crossdressing, gender identity issues and gender roles, said Ariadne Kane, coordinator of the event. The fair is open to all serious people wishing to explore various aspects of femininity.

The nine-day event is also intended to help educate the general public as well

as the participants, Kane said. The public will be invited to attend special seminars, a fashion show and a talent and costume show. Dates and times will be announced.

New this year will be a series of workshops and seminars that deal with specific areas of concern to this subculture. The workshops will concentrate on cosmetic usage and modern social dance. The seminars will discuss the legal, medical and sociological aspects of all crossdresser lifestyles.
