## NEWS RELEASE

Please take note that the Metamorphosis Medical Research Foundation (MMRF) Inc. has been dissolved as of May 21, 1988 per a motion made by the Executive which was voted in favour of by the members in good standing by postal ballot Rupert Raj, the Founding President and former Executive Director of MMRF, has established his own educational resource/counselling resource, GENDER WORKER, (registered with the Ontario Ministry of Consumer and Commercial Relations in September 1987).

Through his new business, a variety of informational services are available including a bimonthly newsletter, "Gender Networker" for helping professionals resource providers and interested others - \$18 for six issues, first issue published in June of 1988.

In addition, THE UNINVITED DILEMMA: A Question Of Gender by Kim Stuart will be continued to be sold (paper edition only, \$12.<sup>50</sup> U.S. or Cdn. equivalent) plus the Research Supplement (\$12.<sup>50</sup> U.S. or Cdn. eq). If both books are ordered at the same time, the total cost is ~~\$22.50~~ U.S. (or Cdn. eq). I have sold close to 200 of this highly-recommended book - an absolute must for everyone's library.

<sup>\$23.25</sup> And, back issues of the "Metamorphosis Magazine" and the newsletter (Vols. 1-7, 1982-88) are still available at a total cost of \$86.
