Many rumors have been circulating about the future of J2CP, since I made my novice promises and began wearing the habit of the Sisters of St. Elizabeth of Hungary.

J2CP continues as the primary international information/referral service for transsexuals, having taken over the service from the JANUS Information Facility, and its predecessor, the Erickson Education Foundation, Renaissance: Gender Identity Services and CORISTA. In addition to maintaining a referral list for most areas of the world, J2CP provides a comprehensive information packet on transsexualism, and an educational outreach to the media and higher education programs.


I am enclosing our latest pamphlet, which is part of our initial response to those seeking information on gender dysphoria syndrome, in particular *transsexualism*. It will provide you some background on J2CP's goals, and the level of our publications.
