Getting Here

From the south - Follow I-85 north to Exit 29 (Ga. 400). Take Exit 2 off 400 (Lenox Road/ Buckhead). At the top of exit ramp, make a right. Continue straight ahead following the signals to Lenox Road. The Terrace Garden and Four Points Hotels are about four blocks on your left.

From the north - Follow I-85 South. Take Exit 30 (Lenox Road). Turn right on Lenox Road and proceed two miles to the Terrace Garden/Four Points Hotels (on your right, opposite Rich's and the Lenox Square Mall).

From the Airport - Easy public transit from airport MARTA rapid rail service is \$1.50 from Hartsfield Airport terminal to Lenox Mall station. Station is one block from the hotels. Clean, safe, fast and easy. Shuttle buses are also available for around \$15 one way. A tax directly from the airport to the



Parking: Free parking is available behind the Terrace Garden and all around the Sheraton Four Points. Those who choose to use the Parking Deck get a special SCC daily rate of \$3.

The daytime schedule of seminars reflects SCC's sincere commitment to serve the diverse needs of our community--from basic info for the newly out to detailed legal, medical and political presentations, and informative sessions on family relationships, sexuality and spirituality. Evenings are given over to celebration; and the gathering of the transgender clan at SCC is always a festive affair. If you enjoy the nightlife, you'll love Southern Comfort -- we provide free shuttle service to after-hours nightclubs each evening.

C outhern Comfort prides itself on being an all-inclusive (and Deconomical) conference. Whatever your connection to the transgender community-whether you are transsexual, crossdresser or in between; spouse, partner or family member; straight, gay, bi or omnisexual; post-op, pre-op or non-op; young or old; married or single; FtM or MtF; or of any variance--if transgender is an issue in your life, you are welcome at Southern Comfort Conference.

CC's home is the elegant Sheraton Buckhead Hotel Atlanta (formerly the Terrace Garden) and the adjacent Four Points Sheraton. The two hotels are side-by-side and located directly across the street from Lenox Square Mall, and half a block from the exclusive shops of Phipps Plaza.
