

CZAR'S OFFICIALS AS FLIRTS.

Two Attaches of the Russian World's Fair Commission Arrested.

CHICAGO, Ill., April 30.—Nicolai De-Raylan, private secretary to L. De-Rayouza Soushchesky, of the Russian imperial commission to the Columbian Exposition, and A. E. Rachatte, a civil engineer attached to the Russian commission, were locked up last night on charges of disorderly conduct preferred by George Burns and John Hayes, son of Police Lieut. Martin Hayes. The complainants allege that the prisoners addressed familiarly two of Lieut. Hayes' daughters, whom they passed while walking on Michigan Avenue near Twenty-fourth Street. Burns and the young ladies' brother were close by and when told of the action called Officers Ryan and Flynn, who arrested and locked them up. Prince Engadicheff was sent for to bail the prisoners out.
